Frequently Asked Questions.

What is ZOOM?

Zoom is a video conferencing service you can use to virtually meet with others - either by video or audio-only or both, all while conducting live chats .

Will it cost me anything?

It will not cost anything to download the Zoom app or attend meetings. The App is **free**. The basic zoom package allows you to join and create meetings for multiple users.

Do I need to download the App?

You can use Zoom without a download through your browser, however you will not be able to use all of the features, we recommend downloading the App for the best experience. We will show you how!

How will I access the meeting/ party?

When you are invited or sign up for a zoom event you will receive an invitation via email, usually about 24 hours before the event, this email will have a URL (link) this is your meeting ID.

To enter the meeting you click on the link OR copy the link into your zoom app. And click JOIN.

Will my meeting ID code work more than once?

YES! As long as the meeting is in progress you can leave and join the meeting using your code as many times as you need.

This can be helpful if your connection drops out.

Can I join the meeting early?

YES! Our hosts will be available up to an hour before the party if you have questions or would like to test your settings before the event, You are most welcome to 'drop in' to test your connection or troubleshoot with our support. We are here to help you have a fun first time experience. Simply use your code to enter the "room".

I am nervous, Will I have to talk?

We are here to make sure the Get Online Zoom Party is a safe and fun way to learn about video conferencing, we would love to hear you share some of what you have learned during Get Online Week, or how increasing your confidence online has been a challenge or positive experience. Our hosts will give you informal opportunities to speak or send live chat by typing your comments if you prefer. Relax and enjoy connecting with others from your region who have taken up the challenge.


