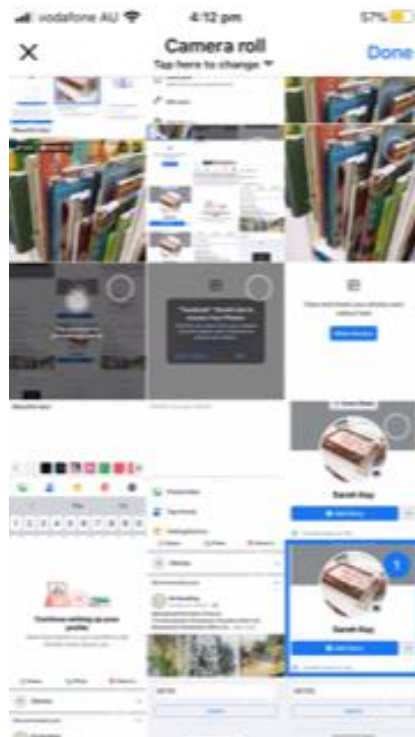
Add a profile picture so friends can find you.

You can add a Profile photo from your Gallery or take a new one or choose Skip.

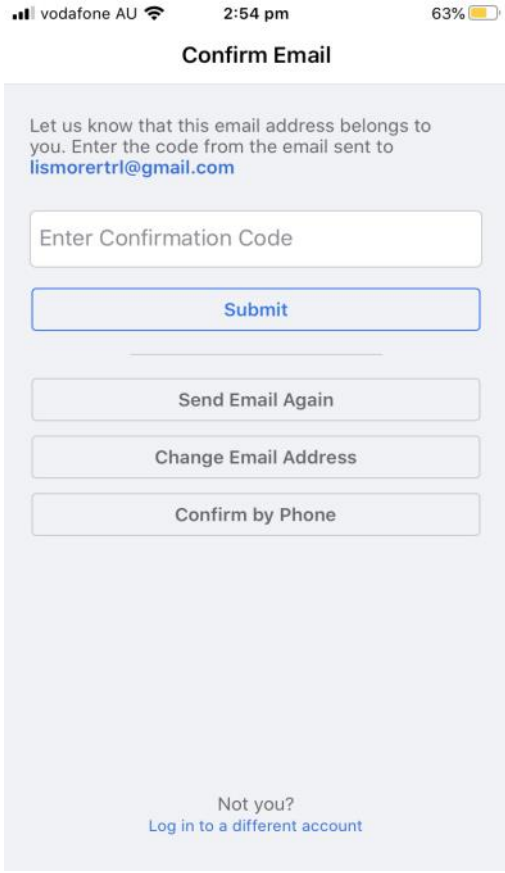


Select a photo from your Gallery

It is best to add your photo so your friends can identify you quickly.

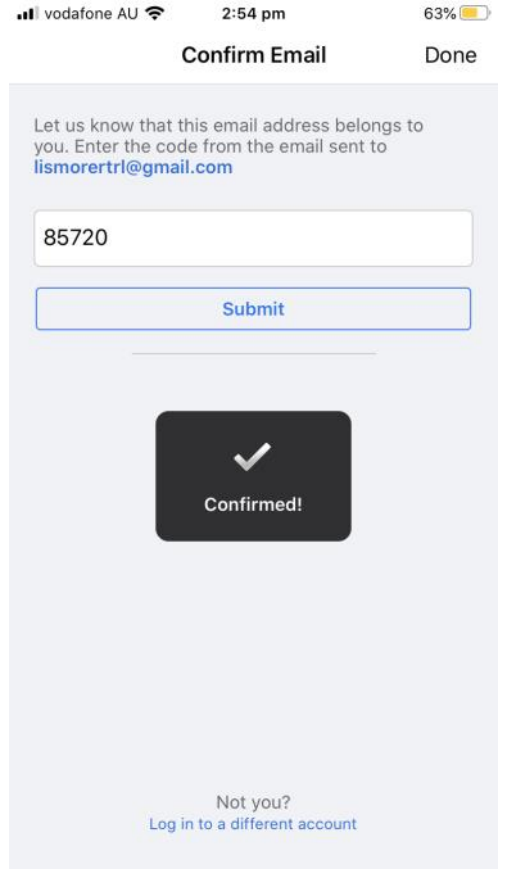
Facebook will send you a confirmation code. Check your email.

Tip - Don't forget to check your junk email.



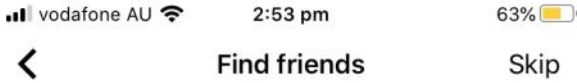
Now you have your own Facebook Profile!

See who's on Facebook by continuously uploading your contacts. Then let us know who you want to add as friends.



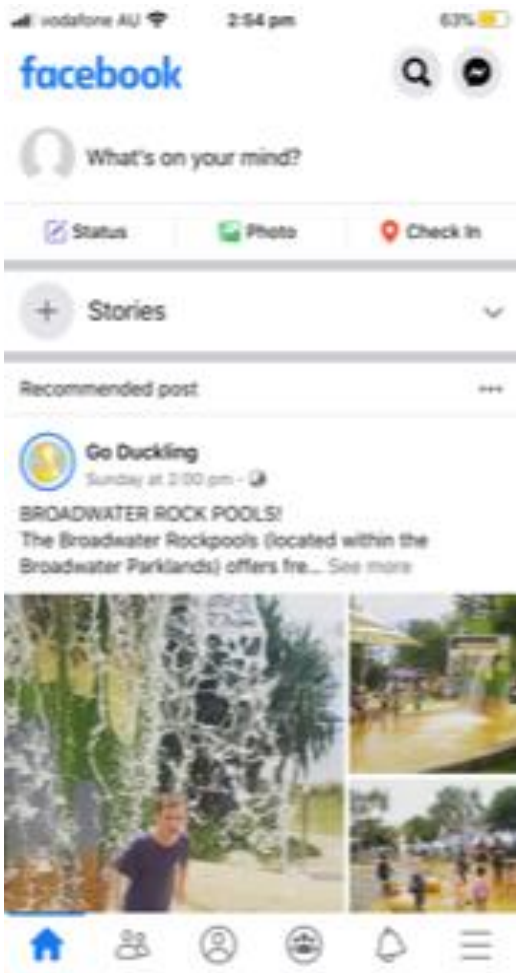

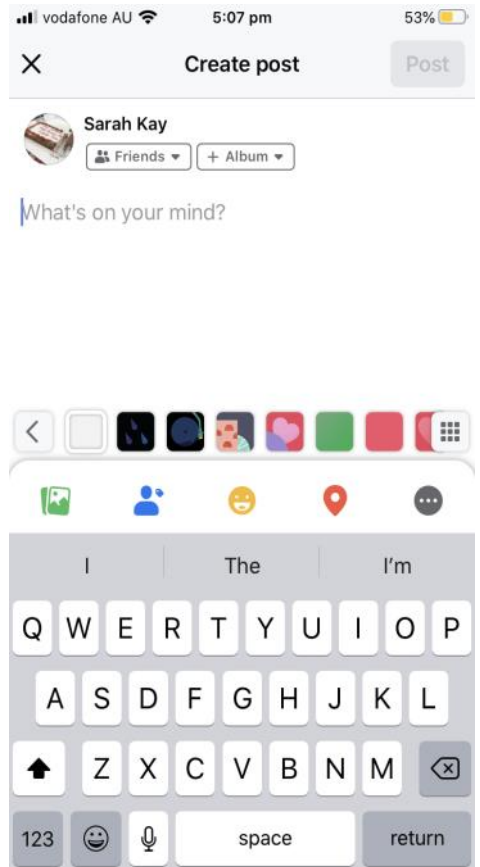
Tap Get Started to **Find Friends**. Or tap **Skip**.

To create a Post, tap on the **'What's on your mind?'** box.

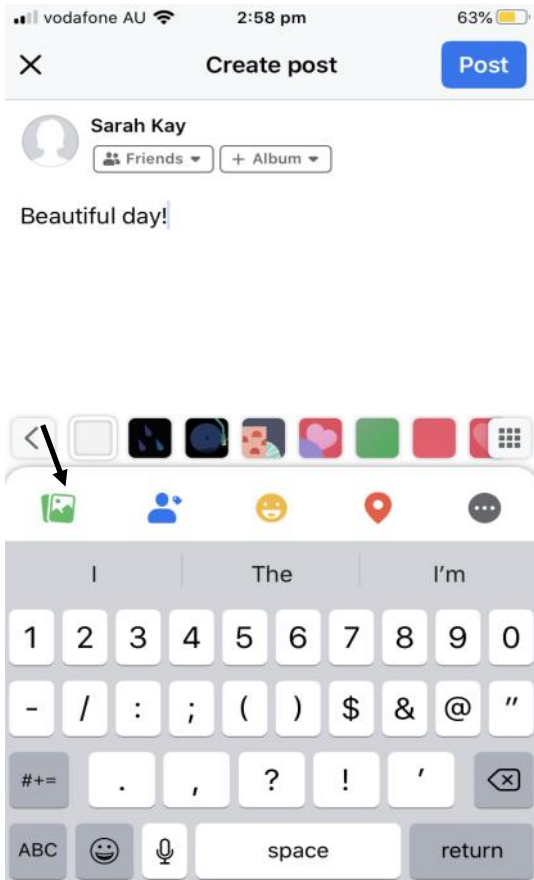


Tap again for your keyboard to come up; start typing, then tap **'Post'**.

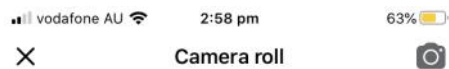


Have a go by tapping each of these icons to see what more you can do.

To add photos, tap on the photo icon.



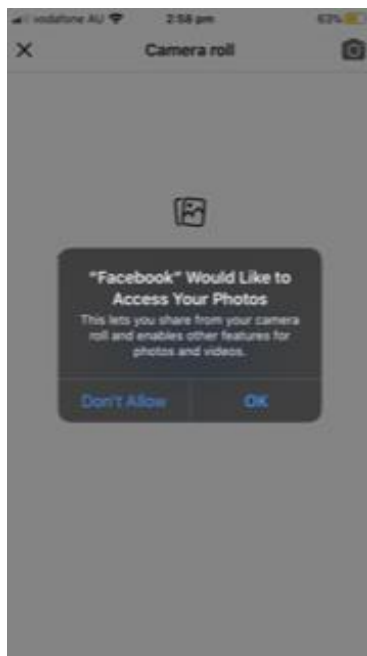
Tap Allow Access.



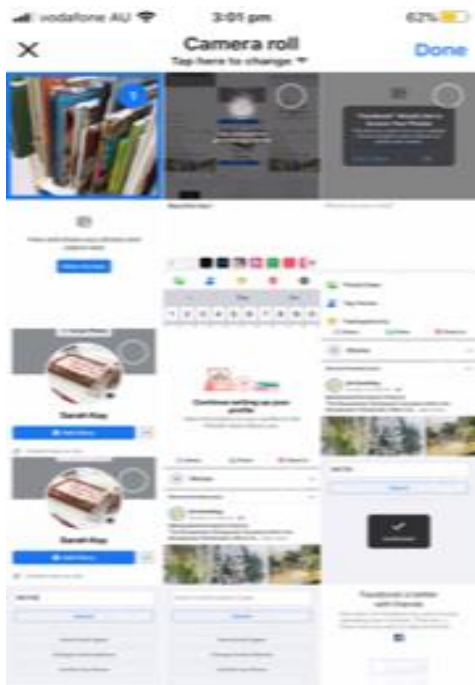

Then tap OK.

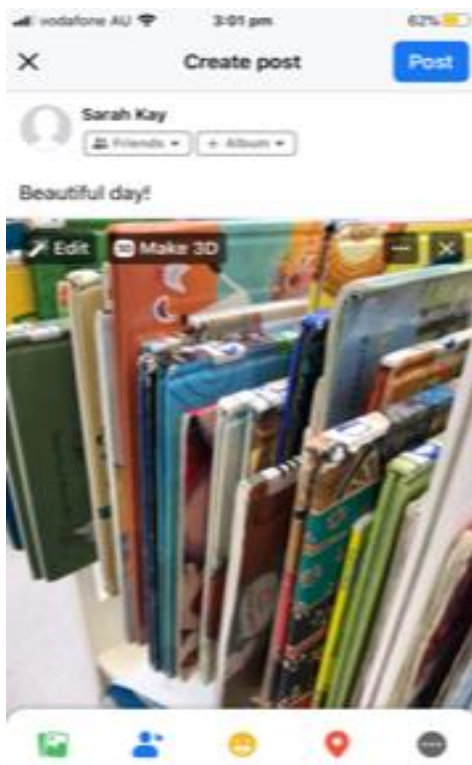


Choose your photo. Your chosen photos will have a blue border and number.



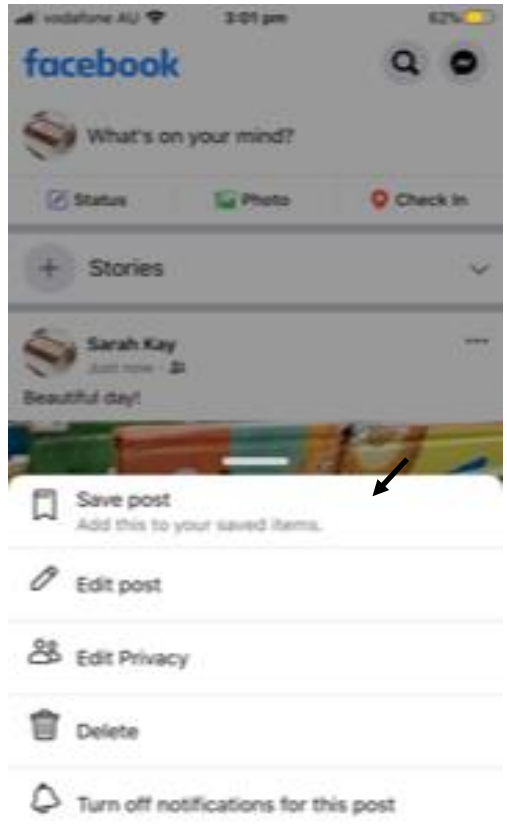
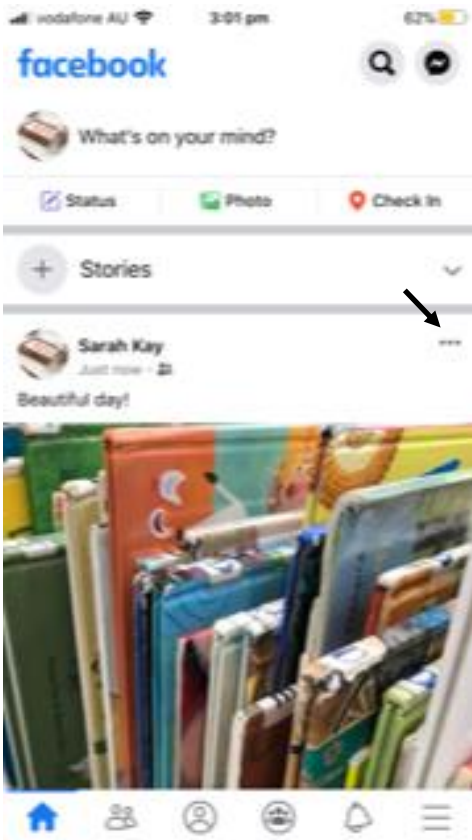
Tip - You can select more than one photo. Tap all the photos you would like to post.
